



NOTICE TO MEMBERS AND GUESTS 20 NOVEMBER 2020 - ENTRY RESTRICTIONS

To our valued Members and Guests,

I am happy to announce that after careful consideration by both the Board and Management, Club Jervis Bay has elected to remove entry restrictions for all members and guests. Club Jervis Bay now welcomes all persons from all Australian States and Territories as well as International visitors. Please note Club Jervis Bay will continue to closely monitor the COVID-19 situation and may elect to make changes to entry restrictions at any time.

Please also note the Club is required to meet its obligations under both the Registered Clubs Act 1976 and the Liquor Act 2007 and requires appropriate ID for all visitors. Any person without appropriate ID will not be permitted entry to the Club.

ID MUST be government issued and contain a person's full name, residential address and birthdate and for any person requiring an evidence of age document (ie 25 or under) the ID MUST be photo ID. International visitors must have a valid passport or drivers license.

Our Club will continue to adhere to a comprehensive set of health and safety standards designed to protect members, guests and our staff. These measures include:

- Recording the names, contact details (e.g. telephone number or email address), and time of entry and exit of every person (including members), staff, contractors and any other person who enters the club, and to retain this information for 28 days for contact tracing purposes.
- Temperature readings of every person entering the premises will be taken. If you record a reading above 37.8 degrees, you will not be permitted to enter and will be encouraged to visit your doctor.
- Every person will be required to apply the alcohol-based sanitiser when entering the Club.
- Alcohol-based sanitiser will be available in each area of the Club and we encourage our members and guests to use this when entering or exiting areas within the Club.
- A hygiene attendant will be cleaning frequently touched surfaces and gaming machines will be wiped down in between uses.
- Additional cleaning staff will be tasked with ensuring restrooms are disinfected several times per hour.
- Group seating will be limited and seating will be spaced apart to ensure social distancing is maintained.
- Our team will be actively monitoring all areas of the Club to ensure social distancing is being observed, and all persons must remain seated.
- Laminated menus and coasters will be in place and cutlery, crockery, condiments and straws will be provided as needed by staff.

We ask anyone who is feeling unwell or has any flu like symptoms to refrain from attending the Club.

Finally, we ask all members and guests to continue to observe good personal hygiene including covering coughs and sneezes with the inner elbow or a clean tissue, avoiding touching the face, eyes, nose or mouth and refraining from physical contact with others such as hugging or shaking hands.
