### ***MOVING FORWARD – Easing of Entry Requirements***

Club Jervis Bay is a people-first culture. We have, and will always prioritise the health, safety and well-being of our staff, customers, and local community.

As a community-spirited hub within the Jervis Bay region, we continue to follow the advice passed down from NSW Health and our industry body, ClubsNSW to provide a safe environment for our community.

From 18 February 2022, as announced by NSW Health, across our state we will see some major changes to conditions of entry into Hospitality venues.

Whilst this announcement is not enforced for Hospitality venues, after discussions with the Club Board and Management team and being led by our values of inclusion and resilience, we are pleased to say we will be adopting these changes as followed:

- Capacity limits to revert to pre-COVID-19 limits.
- QR check – ins are no longer be required.
- Singing and Dancing will be permitted.
- Member's will no longer have to sign in and out of the Club
- Visitors will now only have to sign as per the Registered Clubs Act

We pride ourselves on creating a relaxed, safe, and welcoming environment for all our members and their guests; we are a family friend who truly cares for our people. We continue to take this lead by following the recommendations of our chief health professionals and adapting to changes through calm and deliberate actions, placing safety first.
